INTRODUCTION

To promote humane, judicious and scientific handling and management of laboratory animals, a Certificate Course in Laboratory Animal Science was conceptualised and an MoU was signed amongst TANUVAS, CPCSEA, NIAW and LASA India in February 2013. Two such courses were conducted at Madras Veterinary College, TANUVAS, Chennai in 2013 and 2014. A total of 58 scientists from Government and private sector have so far benefitted from the training.

The objective of this certificate course is to meet the quality standards prescribed by FELASA (Federation of European Laboratory Animal Science Associations) addressed to persons carrying out and responsible for directing animal experiments (former Category 'C' course) and impart training to the scientists involved in using the laboratory animals for research in India. This training programme is intended to provide the foundation for responsible use of laboratory animals and achievement of high scientific standards and enable the scientists to be fully competent to undertake animal work on their own responsibility.

Based on the quality of training imparted in the previous training programmes, **FELASA has accredited this course for Species: Rodents and Fish (functions A, B, C & D).** This is the only course accredited by FELASA outside Europe.

COURSE CONTENT

The course is designed to impart theoretical knowledge and provide practical exposure to the participants in laboratory animal science and management as per the requirements for persons carrying out and responsible for directing animal

experiments. The syllabus includes Biology and Husbandry of laboratory animals, Microbiology and Diseases of laboratory animals, Health hazards and Safe practices in the animal house, Design and Conduct of animal experiments, Anaesthesia, Analgesia and Experimental procedures, Alternatives to animal use, Analysis of Scientific literature and Ethical aspects and Legislation.

DETAILS OF TRAINING

The training will be held from 7th Dec 2015 to 17th Dec 2015 with a day's break in between. The training will have lectures from experts, practical hands on sessions, assignments, case studies and group tasks. The participants will be evaluated for their competency at the end of the course. On successful completion the participants will be issued certificates approved by FELASA.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Essential Qualification: The participant should have undergraduate degree in Veterinary / Medical Sciences or postgraduate degree / research scholars in Life sciences

Desirable Qualification: Persons with minimum of three years of experience in handling the laboratory animals for research or permanent position in laboratory animal house management.

HOW TO APPLY?

The participants are requested to fill in the application form in the given format and send the hard copy of the form along with a brief resume of the candidate through proper channel so as to reach the 'Organizing Secretary, Certificate Course in Laboratory Animal Science, Laboratory Animal Medicine Unit, Directorate of Centre for

Animal Health Studies, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Madhavaram Milk Colony, Chennai 600 051, Tamil Nadu' **on or before 09.11.2015.**

Scanned copy of the duly signed and forwarded application along with a brief resume of the candidate may be mailed to the Organizing Secretary by email (lamdcahs@tanuvas.org.in, ramesh@tanuvas.org.in) as an advance copy. Selected candidates will be intimated by e-mail to which they should promptly send their confirmation.

Applications received after the last date or with incomplete details or not forwarded through proper channel will not be entertained. The payment made by the non-selected candidates will be returned.

COURSE FEE

Course fee will be Rs. 15,000/- for participants working in Government institutes and Rs. 30,000/- for participants working in non-government organizations or private institutes. The course fee is inclusive of service tax. Payment may be made by Demand draft in favour of 'The Organizing Secretary, Certificate Course in Laboratory Animal Science' or through Net banking (A/c No. 332902010721783; IFSC code: UBIN0533297).
